

10 things you should know about the VCSE in Gloucestershire

There are over 5500 VCSE organisations in Gloucestershire.



Almost 7000 people are employed by registered charities, with over 14000 volunteers.









The most common areas of support are for older people, rural areas and health.



Registered charities, excluding educational institutions, had an income of £464,662,775 in 2018-19.

33.6% of organisations have a turnover of £25,000 or less.



87% of organisations receive grant funding which remains the lifeblood of the sector.





50% of VCSE organisations deliver on public sector contracts.



73% of organisations surveyed were concerned about their long-term future.

Problems in recruiting volunteers poses an ongoing risk to the viability of small organisations.



Over 52% of VCSE organisations thought that recruiting Trustees was an ongoing problem.
